

VŌ plans, attracts, and delivers a broad range of over 400 ticketed, business, civic, lifestyle, wedding, culinary, and community events annually, including major entertainment and sporting events in Christchurch, through the management and use of a diverse and iconic portfolio of community venues.

VŌ's mission is to strategically manage and leverage the venues to deliver positive social, cultural, environmental, and economic benefit to the region.

Established over 25 years ago, VŌ owns the Christchurch Town Hall and Wolfbrook Arena, and manages the Air Force Museum of New Zealand, Apollo Projects Stadium, and Hagley Oval. It also operates One New Zealand Stadium, due to open in April 2026, and delivers large-scale mobile events through its 'VŌ Events' arm.

The events delivered across the portfolio of VŌ venues contribute an estimated \$46 million annually to the Canterbury region's economy, including around \$12 million to local suppliers and producers through its 'Celebrate and Source Local' procurement strategy. With the opening of One NZ Stadium in 2026, this estimated contribution will increase to around \$100 million.

VŌ hosts around 650,000 guests annually and employs team of over 500 local staff. With the addition of One NZ Stadium, annual guest numbers will grow to over 900,000, annual events to over 500 and the VŌ team will grow to over 1,000.

Guided by the Māori value of Manaakitanga, VŌ operates with boldness, agility, aspiration, and kindness. As a team, we are proud and privileged to manage a remarkable portfolio of venues, and we are committed to positively contributing to the prosperity and well-being of the Canterbury region in everything we do.
